

30th Family Reunion June 20, 1971

The 30th Reunion meeting was called to order Sunday afternoon at Mac Arthur Park in San Antonio, Texas.

First on the agenda was the Memorial Service for members who had passed away during the previous year. They were Emily Scholz, Karlina Tomlinson, and Margaret Jo Dodgen (Granddaughter of Erie and Clark von Rosenberg). The Memorial Service was conducted by Mrs. Paula Hein

Next was the Treasurer's report by Robert Hein. He reported a total of \$281.38 in the Family Savings Account. Also the Book Fund had reached a total of \$263.62. \$18.00 was collected at this year's Reunion and a total of \$29.00 was spent in mailing the Newsletter.

A discussion on the newsletters which were returned followed. The names and addresses of those returned were read aloud to those present, however most were unknown. Members were requested to contact as many members as possible to increase attendance next year.

Charles von Rosenberg volunteered to help in organizing the 2nd Volume of the Family Book, to be published shortly. His offer was accepted by those present. Charles expressed his desire that all members help him in compiling the information on those to be included on the book. The responsibility for this information was delegated to each of the Branch Chairmen's for their particular Branch. However a problem came up in that some of the chairmen were either deceased or a Branch did not have one. a discussion of the chairmen followed and new ones were named for those Branches that did not have one.

The Officers for next year's Reunion were nominated and elected.

was possible this was the reason for the decline in attendance.

Alexander Meerscheidt extended an invitation to meet at his place in Rockport, Texas. The motion was given to those present to accept Alex's offer by Kathleen Schock, seconded and passed by those present.

Also the Reunion would be held on June 25, 1972.

Recognition was given to the youngest member present- Robert Meerscheidt 1 year's old. The oldest member present- Henry Hein, 83 years old. And the members who traveled the farthest distance- Glen von Rosenberg family from Nashville, Tennessee.
