

Minutes of the 70<sup>th</sup> Reunion  
von Rosenberg Family of Texas  
Saturday July 21, 2012

Call to order 1:15 pm – 63 members present

30<sup>th</sup> yr at camp lone star, 163<sup>rd</sup> yr since Peter Carl's arrival in Texas
