

VON ROSENBERG FAMILY REUNION

PLACE: The acreage of Alexander O. Meerscheidt between the cities of Aransas Pass and Rockport, Texas. See accompanying map for directions.

DATE: June 25, 1972, last Sunday in June.

TIME: Register between 10:00 and 11:00 a.m.

BRING: Eating utensils, drinking containers and desserts only. The meal will be furnished at the site.

COST: One dollar per family registration fee.  
Two dollars per family meal charge.  
Any donations over this three dollars will be gladly accepted.

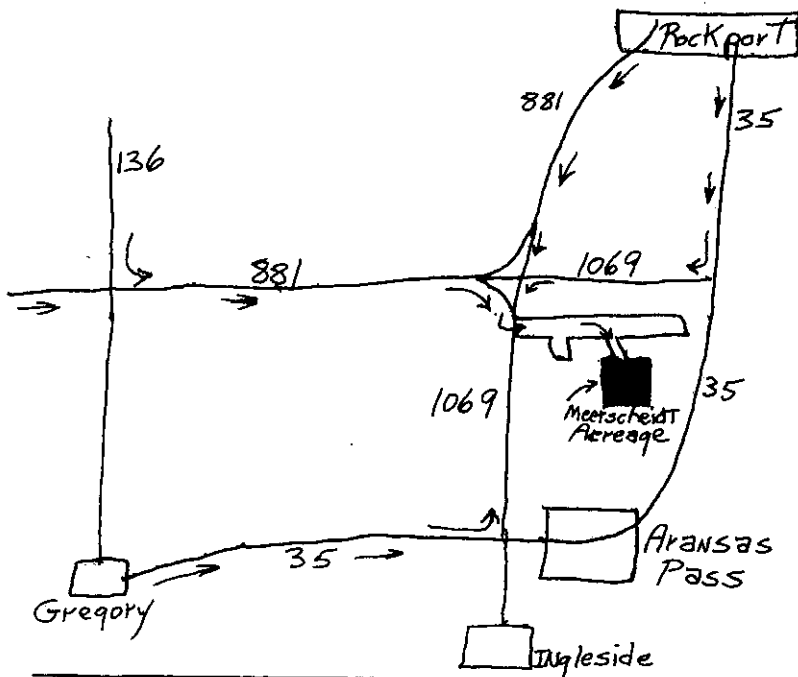
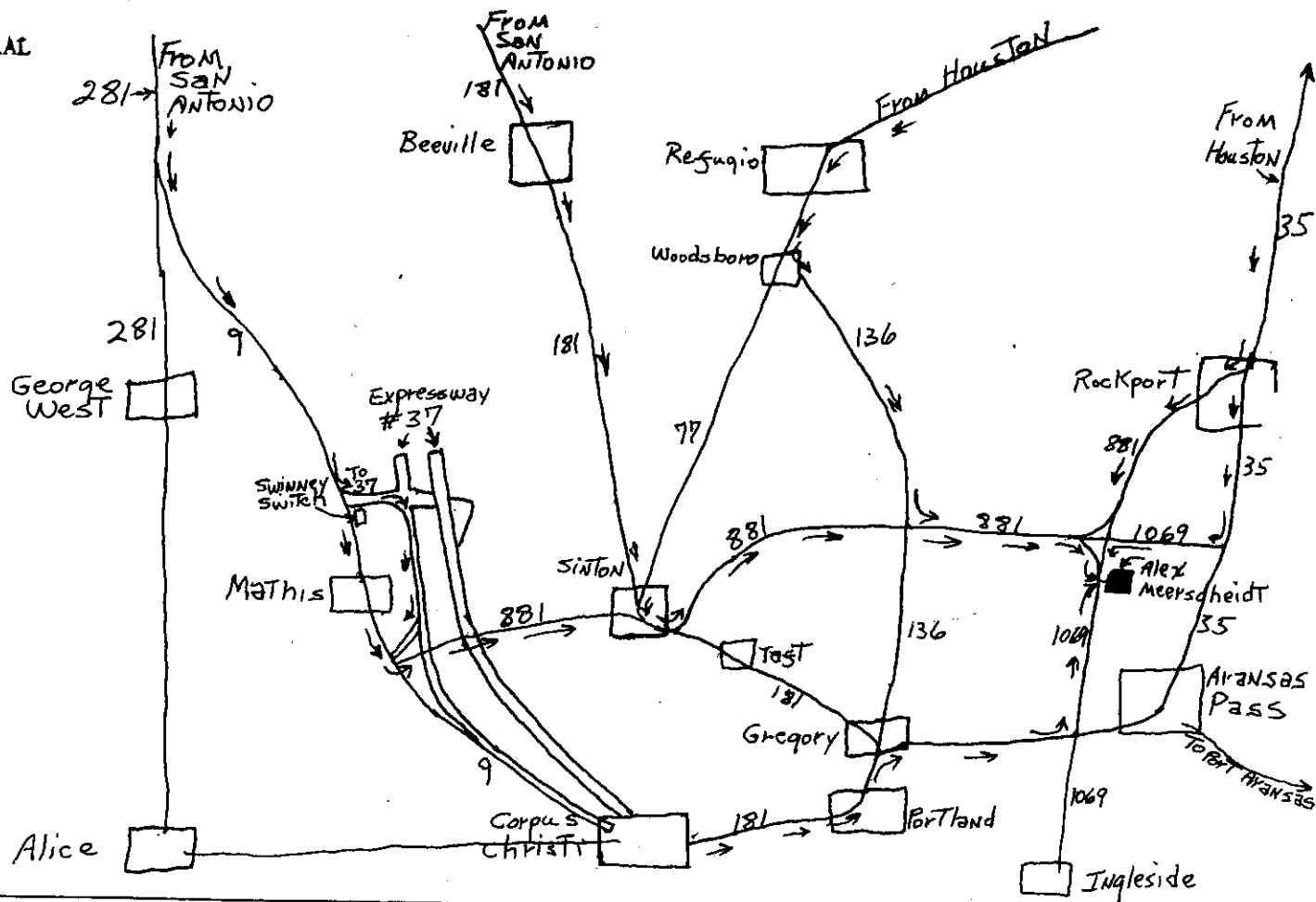
