DALE U. LETTER

The following article is submitted by our Family Historian, Dr. Dale U. von Rosenberg of Dallas and is perhaps the most important document carried in this Newsletter in some time. It is self-explanatory and is reproduced in its entirety. I beg you'll pay heed to it, give it your serious consideration, and then ACT.

"NEEDED: PEOPLE TO HELP WITH VOLUME III

For several years I have been trying to find time to begin collecting information for Volume III. I have determined the number of biographies we will need from each branch and sub-branch, and I have written instructions for writing biographies and for gathering family information as to marriages, births, and deaths in the family since the publication of Volume II. However, with the responsibilities both inside and outside my work, I have only a few hours each month to spend on Volume III, and this is just not enough time. I can help with the planning and the organizing of the work, but I will need much help in executing the plans.

We need at least one person to be in charge of gathering information for each of the 29 sub-branches of the family. A sub-branch consists of the descendants of generation III. We need biographies of 419 members of generation V. I have identified a number of persons who might be willing to help in several of the sub-branches. However, finding time to contact these people and help them obtain this information is one task which I just do not have time to do.

The first person we need is someone to contact and line up all these people who will help write the biographies and obtain the information. Then, as this information comes in, several people will be needed to begin organizing and editing the biographies and to get all the family records updated.

We should seriously consider obtaining a good geneological computer program, and the use of a computer, so that the family records can be

entered into that program. Someone with the proper expertise is needed to determine which program we should purchase. After we raise the money, purchase the program, and obtain the use of a computer, all the information in Volume II plus all the updates which Phil Meerscheidt has obtained since 1974 must be entered into the program. Then, as new information is obtained, it can be readily added to the program.

As you have read this, you will have identified at least three or four full-time positions, in addition to the chairmen for the 29 sub-branches. If you want to help in any way, write me, Dale U. von Rosenberg, at 6036 Del Norte Lane, Dallas, Texas 75225, or telephone me at (214) 739-0649.

CLIPPING

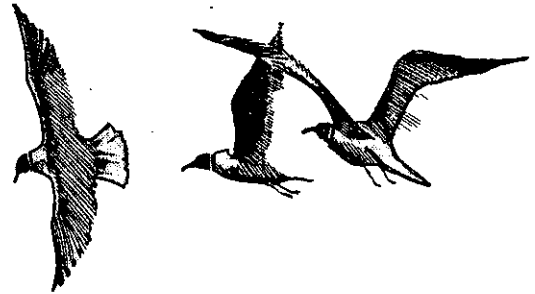
I clipped the following from the Houston Post newspaper Aug. 4, 1991:
