2016 REUNION - JULY 15-17, 2016 AT CAMP LONE STAR IN LA GRANGE, TEXAS

Greetings Family! The 75th annual reunion of the von Rosenberg Family of Texas will be happening this coming Summer on July 15th through July 17th. As was agreed to by the family at last year's reunion, we will again be meeting at Camp Lone Star just outside La Grange, Texas. Please plan on attending, as we want and encourage as many of our fellow von Rosenberg relations to come and enjoy the reunion.

REUNION DETAILS

Highlights of the 2016 Reunion will be:

- Golf Tournament @ either the Lost Pines or Colovista resorts in Bastrop on Friday, July 15th. Tee-time is tentatively set for 1:00 pm, however this is subject to change. - On Saturday morning, we will travel to La Grange to visit the Fayette Heritage Museum & Archives to view the von Rosenberg Family collection on display in their research room upstairs. The FHMA is now open only on Saturdays from 10:00 am until 5:00pm and further information can be found at www.fayettecountyhistory.org/fhm_archives.htm.
- A *tentative* plan for a new book presentation is planned for Saturday at Camp Lone Star at 2:00 pm to feature noted Texas Author, Skip Hollandsworth, and his new book; [The Midnight Assassin](#). This true crime novel features in part our ancestor/relation, Judge William von Rosenberg, Jr. of Branch I, who was serving as the Justice of the Peace of Travis County in 1895 when a serial killer struck Austin, Texas. The killer was alternately known as the Servant Girl Annihilator, the Austin Axe Murderer and as the book's title implies, the Midnight Assassin. Mr. Hollandsworth, who also is executive editor at Texas Monthly magazine, has not yet committed to the presentation, however we are actively seeking his attendance. If he is unable to attend, we will simply visit with each other.
- Following lunch on Saturday, an informal history show and tell will be held at Camp Lone Star where family members with interesting family artifacts will be available to show other family members their heirlooms and artifacts. We encourage any and all von Rosenberg cousins to search their closets and attics and cedar chests to look for old photographs, or civil war mementos, or other types of items which tell the history of our family.

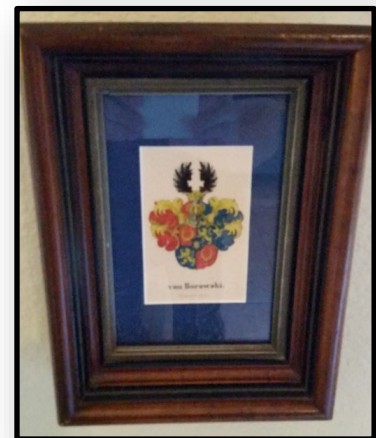

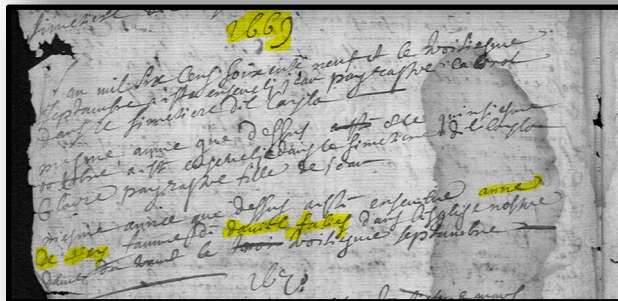
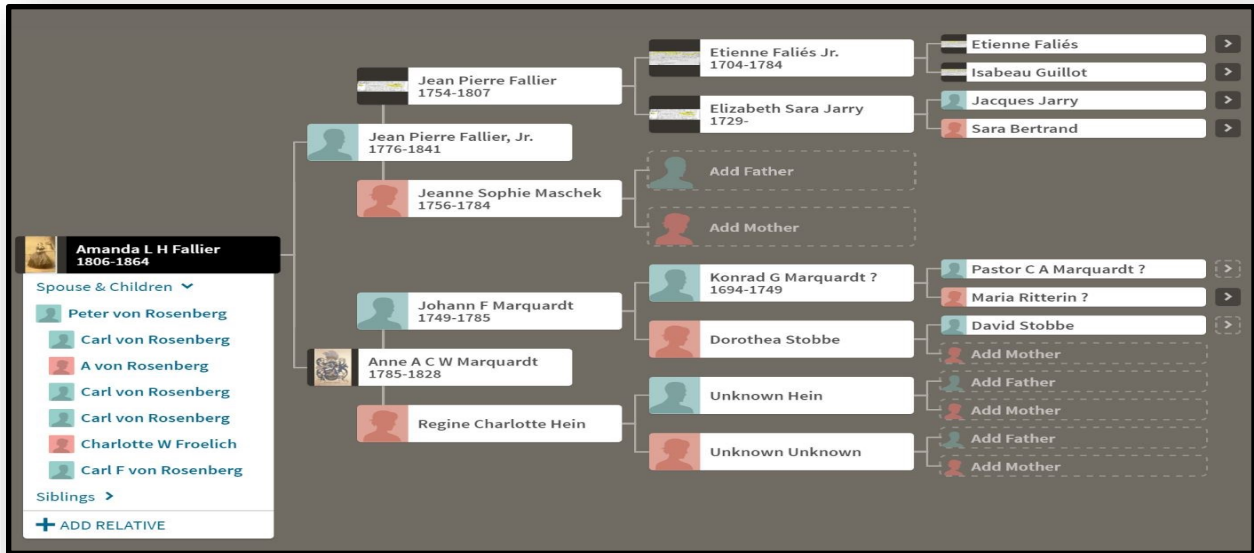

Crest of the von Borowski family (ancestors of Albert von Rosenberg's wife, Monica von Struve)

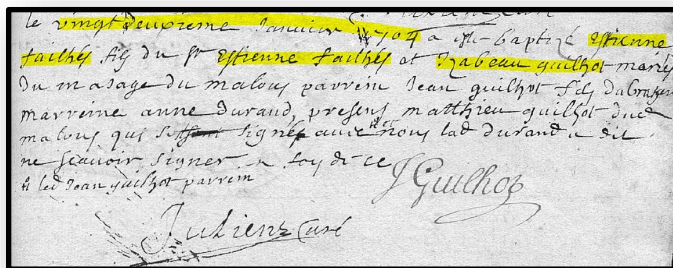
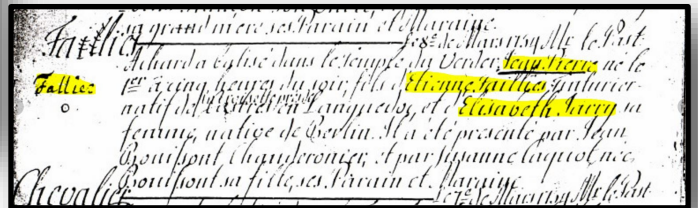
FALLIER FAMILY DOCUMENTATION

Recently, several documents were discovered online which confirm the genealogical history of the Fallier family to which more than half the von Rosenberg descendants belong by virtue of their descent from the pioneer mother, Amanda Fallier von Rosenberg, Peter Carl's second wife. The Fallier family name was originally known as Faliés and they originated in the Languedoc-Midi-Pyrénées region of southern France, where they were members of the French protestant faith, better known as Huguenots. Specifically, the Faliés ancestors came from the villages of La Travet and Lacrouzette in the Tarn department.

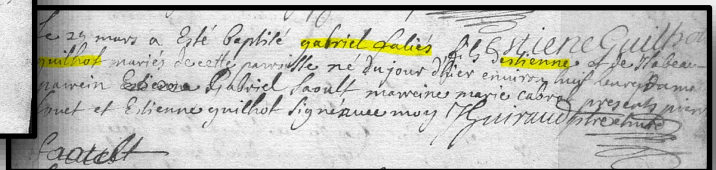

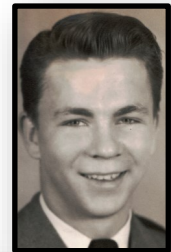

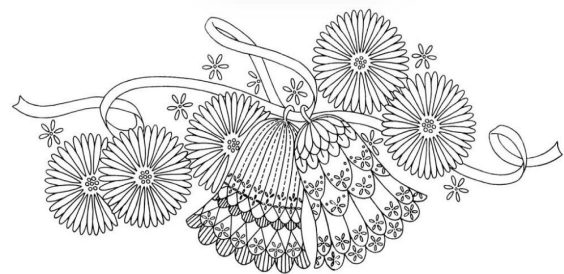
PASSINGS

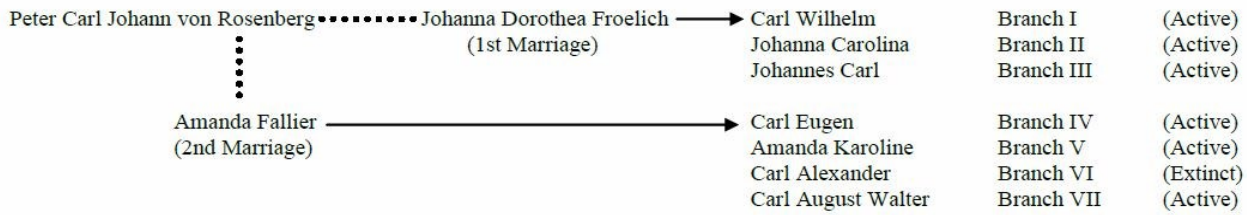

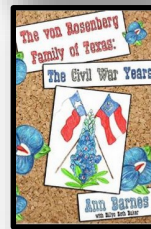

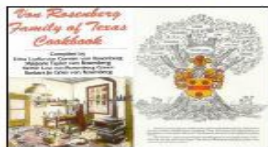

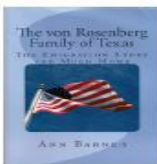
